

Entry Level Class Offering: 18th Century Carved Footstool

I will be teaching a class on making a carved footstool in two sessions. Each session is 2 days. The classes will be held in my shop in Eagan, MN. A footstool is a great entry level project because the construction is simple and straight forward, but there are four opportunities for a ball & claw foot, four opportunities for a knee carving and two chances at an applied shell. In addition the student will have some flexibility for the embellishments on the knee, either a shell or a more complicated foliage.

The dates of the two sessions are:

11 - 12 June 2022 (Sat - Sun) Ball & Claw foot and construction overview.
24 - 25 Sept 2022 (Sat - Sun) Knee carving and wrap up.

The student supplies his/her own materials and tools.
