

REPLICA MODEL OF A FAMILY SHIP NEEDED. The 700 foot long William H. Wolf carried ore thru the Great Lakes in the early 1900's operated by the family's Gartland Steamship company. The ship (boat) was scrapped in 1960 and what remains is a 35 inch replica which is a cherished possession of the remaining family members. It has been difficult to pass the replica around and the family would like to contract the crafting of a second version. The current model is 35 inches long by 4 inches wide made from softwood. Important features to capture will be: cargo hold covers, the pilots cabin, the crew quarters, navigation devices and lifeboats, all painted with the proper graphics.
